### Reflective Wear Compliance

Reflective wear is a required safety measure designed to enhance visibility and reduce the risk of accidents in operational areas of the Airport. High-visibility apparel allows vehicle operators and equipment drivers to clearly identify personnel, particularly during low-light conditions, nighttime operations, early morning hours, and periods of reduced visibility.

Employees assigned to work in designated areas are responsible for always wearing approved reflective wear, in accordance with airport policy. Reflective garments must be worn properly, remain visible, and not be covered or obscured by outer clothing, equipment, or personal items.

Noncompliance with reflective wear requirements creates unnecessary safety risks and may result in corrective action. Adhering to this policy supports safe airport operations, regulatory compliance, and the protection of all employees and airport users.

Visibility is a shared responsibility—compliance ensures safety.
